



Already inhabited in pre-Nuragic times, it saw its heyday in Roman times, becoming a military station under Emperor Augustus.

In the Middle Ages it became a department of the Giudicato d'Arborea and underwent various dominations until today when Austis is part of the Comunità Montana of Gennargentu-Mandrolisai and is considered an integral part of the Barbagia di Ollolai.





Austis is the perfect place for those who love holidays immersed in nature thanks to its territory, which is among the most varied in the whole of Sardinia.
